



Wine Industry Planning Grant

Summary: A one-year planning grant to evaluate the region's wine industry to identify gaps to strengthening the sector and drive exports across state lines.

Type: Cluster Scale Up (Grow Existing Business)

Sector: Food & Beverage Manufacturing

Localities: Counties of Albemarle, Culpeper, Fauquier, Fluvanna, Greene, Louisa, Madison, Nelson, Orange, Rappahannock and the City of Charlottesville

Deliverable: A report that summarizes findings including recommendations, action plan, and GO Virginia grants.

Project VITAL: Charlottesville Biotechnology Accelerator

Summary: A 3-year grant to build wet lab space and provide critical services to early-stage start-ups includes internships and other sector activities.

Type: Cluster Scale Up (Grow Existing Business)

Sector: Biotechnology

Localities: Charlottesville, Albemarle

Other Support: UVA, Private Sector

Outcomes: 90 entrepreneurs engaged, 68 jobs created, 15 internships created, 15 jobs retained, 10 businesses attracted, 15 businesses retained, 10 businesses expanded, 60 businesses served, 5 new products releases, \$12M capital raised.




